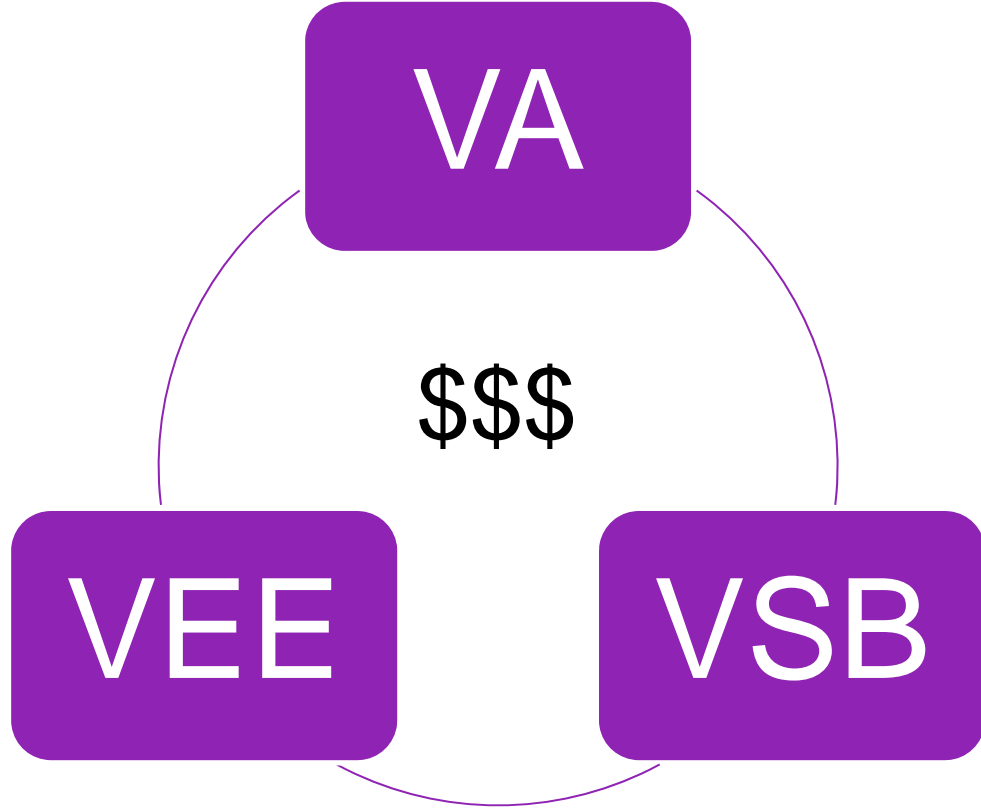

 - objective, rubrics

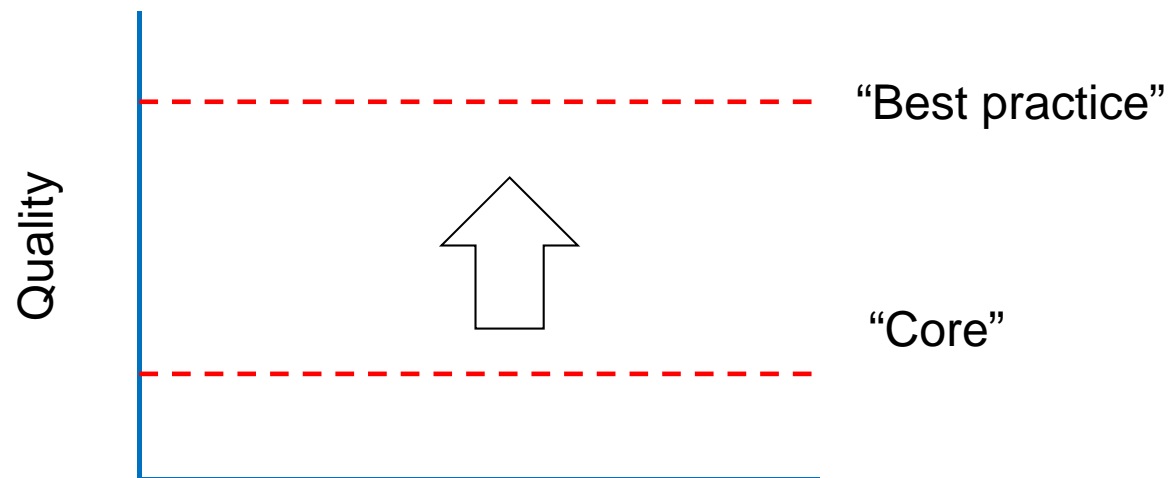
