Laurent Msellati joined the World Bank in 1991. He is currently Operations Adviser in the Central Operational Services Department for the East Asia and Pacific Region of the World Bank where he leads the Quality, Results and Trust Funds Team, based in Washington DC. Prior to this position Mr. Msellati spent several years in the World Bank Office in Hanoi as Portfolio and Operations Manager for Vietnam, and in Rabat as the rural sector coordinator for Morocco.

His graduate degrees are a Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine obtained in France (1983) and an MBA from the University Luigi Bocconi in Milan, Italy (1988). Prior to joining the Bank, Mr. Msellati worked as a private veterinarian in Brittany, managed a large dairy ranch in Argentina, spent two years in Bolivia with the European Commission and three years with the *Centre de Coopération Internationale en Recherche Agronomique pour le Développement* (CIRAD), a French research institute.
