### Epidemiology

#### Epidemiological comments

An intensified surveillance in accordance with the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code was carried out during a three-month period after this H5N2 outbreak was detected. The clinical investigations and the surveillance performed in the surrounding farms within a 3-km radius around the index native chicken farm have finished. In the meantime, two native chicken farms were identified as low pathogenic avian influenza H5N2 subtype and reported to the OIE on 4 January 2013 and 18 January 2013. Afterwards, no other notifiable avian influenza case was observed or detected around the index farm. According to the aforementioned information, this H5N2 avian influenza outbreak in P'eng-hu County was resolved on 28 March 2013.
