Dr Chumnarn Pongsri is the Secretary-General of the Southeast Asian Fisheries Development Center (SEAFDEC). He graduated his B.Sc. in Fisheries from the Faculty of Fisheries, Kasetsart University in 1981, M.Sc. in Aquaculture from the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) in 1985, and Ph.D. from the University of Wales, UK in 1994.

He started working with the Department of Fisheries of Thailand since 1981 as Fisheries Biologist in several provinces in the north-eastern part of Thailand. From 2000 to 2003, he was the Director of the Environment Division of the Mekong River Commission (MRC) Secretariat and also served as Member of the Board of Advisors for the Greater Mekong Sub-region Academic Research Network (GMSARN), after which he returned to the DOF and continued working as a Senior Fisheries Biologist and Expert in Ecology.

Dr Chumnarn also served as Secretary to the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives until 2009 when he was appointed as the Secretary-General of SEAFDEC.
