Dr Florência A. Massango Cipriano concluded in 1986 her degree in Veterinary Medicine at the Veterinary Faculty- Eduardo Mondlane University – Maputo, Mozambique. She obtained a Diploma on Tropical Poultry Production – Belgium in 1989.

In 2003 obtained a certificate in Epidemiology and Informatics and Data handling at the African Union Center for Ticks and Tick Borne Diseases in Malawi.

The 25 years of her professional experience includes public and private sectors work and management of livestock and veterinary programs, particularly design and implementation of disease prevention and control programs for private poultry companies, public policy for national animal health control programs, subject matter specialist for veterinary extension services and management of Veterinary Services at local, provincial and National levels.

During her professional carrier she has contributed in the design of national animal health legislation and for the drafting of aquatic animal's legislation.

Dr. Cipriano occupied the positions of head of provincial division of Livestock and Veterinary services, head of the Epidemiology Unit and since 2006 to date, she serves as the National Director for Veterinary Services in Mozambique and in this capacity since then, has been the OIE Delegate.

Dr. Cipriano collaborates as member of the OIE Council since 2009.

Dr. Cipriano's part time occupations include part-time lecturing at the Veterinary Faculty (Eduardo Mondlane University) of practical poultry production subject, consultancy work on the livestock/veterinary fields and events facilitation.
