Veterinary at the Austral University of Chile (1986) and Dr. med. vet. of the Ludwig-Maximilians University of Munich Germany (1994), serves as a Professor of the Veterinary Sciences Faculty in the Austral University of Chile. Currently Director of the Animal Pathology Institute and Vice-President of the Aquatic Animal Health Standards Commission of the World Animal Health Organization (OIE) and Advisor of SERNAPESCA (Aquatic Competent Authority of Chile).

For 19 years he has done intensive work as an academic, researcher and consultant in the field of infectious diseases in aquatic animals, especially of fish and shellfish, having supervised a significant number of thesis and seminars in undergraduate students, Masters and Ph.D. degree. He has participated in 34 research projects aimed at solving the problems of infectious diseases in aquatic animals. Professionally serves by giving the diagnostic of diseases in aquatic animals and provides advice to producers in Chile, as well as in Mexico through United Nations Development Programs.

Dr Enriquez has 36 publications in journals with editorial board and 87 presentations at conferences in his field.
