Dr Ryan Carnegie is a Research Assistant Professor at the Virginia Institute of Marine Science, College of William and Mary, in Gloucester Point, Virginia, USA.

He is a molluscan pathologist and parasitologist, and leads the OIE Reference Laboratory for *Perkinsosis* and *Haplosporidiosis*. He received degrees from Rutgers University, the College of William and Mary, and a PhD from the University of Maine, USA, which he followed with post-doctoral training at the Pacific Biological Station in Nanaimo, British Columbia, Canada, and the Medical University of South Carolina.

His program's research focuses on the phylogeography of molluscan parasites and the evolutionary ecology of host-parasite relationships, with an emphasis on parasitoses of oysters.
