

Dr Kazuaki Miyagishima



Kazuaki Miyagishima studied medicine and received his Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Tokyo, Japan. He also received an international diploma of public administration from the Ecole Nationale d'Administration, France, and a Ph.D degree in medical sciences from Showa University, Japan. After a postgraduate study in physiology, he joined the Japanese Ministry of Health and Welfare as medical officer, where he was responsible for health policy and planning, maternal and child health, medical personnel training, and mental health, among others. From 1994 to 1998, he worked in the Food Safety Programme at the WHO headquarters, Geneva. In 1998 he became Associate Professor in public health and health policy at Kyoto University, Japan. In 2003, he was appointed Secretary, Codex Alimentarius Commission, by the Directors-General of FAO and WHO.
