Dr Torres studied Veterinary Medicine and Animal Husbandry at the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), from where he obtained his veterinary degree in 1992. He stayed with UNAM teaching Animal Nutrition and Feeding with the Animal Feeding and Nutrition, and Forage production at the Animal Nutrition and Biochemistry department and the Center for Teaching, Research and Extension in the highlands, respectively until 1994 when he went to New Zealand to work on a Master's in Applied Animal Science at Massey University. He worked for several companies as technical service representative and technical sales manager primarily for the cattle and poultry industries in Mexico from 1997 to 2003 when he moved to the USA to work on a doctorate degree with the University of Arkansas focused on poultry gut health and evaluating performance of commercial poultry flocks after treatment with probiotics and prebiotics. He has been with Cobb-Vantress since February 2006 as their veterinarian exports manager where he oversees compliance with health requirements from importing countries and also is responsible for the logistics of the international transport of breeding parent and grand-parent stock. He participates with different organizations involved with international trade regulations for the poultry industry.
