Epidemiology

Epidemiological comments

The disease was reported in captive game bird (Macaw) (non-commercial poultry) at Lahore Zoo. The game birds were destroyed under the supervision of state zoo veterinarian and Stamping out policy was observed. The premises were cleaned/disinfected and surveillance of the outbreak and epidemiological investigations have completed. No further outbreaks of Avian influenza have been reported/recorded since 02 February, 2018. More than three-month have elapsed since cleaning and disinfection of the last outbreak. Pakistan's status as free from highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) has not been affected by this outbreak in wild bird, in accordance with point 8 of Article 10.4.1. of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code. Therefore, a Member Country should not impose bans on the trade in poultry and poultry commodities in response to such a notification, or other information on the presence of any influenza A virus in birds other than poultry, including wild birds.
