Epidemiology

Epidemiological comments

After the H7N9 event occurred in Liaozhong District (Shenyang City, Liaoning Province), in accordance with the requirements for prevention and control of avian influenza in the relevant contingency plans and technical regulations, Liaozhong District immediately defined the affected point, the affected areas and the threatened areas, implemented blockades on the affected areas, culled the remaining 8,000 chickens in the affected flock and disposed of the culled chickens in biosafe method. According to the relevant regulations on the blockade of avian influenza-affected areas, no new cases occurred for 21 days of surveillance after the establishment of blockades in the affected area. On 15 June, the Shenyang Rural & Economic Committee's experts conducted an assessment with the aim of lifting the blockade. The permission was granted, and the local government officially lifted the blockade of the affected area at 0:00 on 16 June. The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs requires the local animal husbandry and veterinary sectors continuously to strengthen the surveillance and monitoring on avian influenza, and to take active prevention and control measures to prevent the H7N9 reoccurrence.
